

The Canadian Cattle Identification Agency (CCIA) is an industry-initiated and led, not-for-profit organization incorporated to establish a national livestock identification program to support efficient trace back and containment of serious animal health and food safety concerns in the Canadian livestock industry.

While the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) provides full regulatory enforcement for animal identification as defined in the Health of Animals Regulations, CCIA is the Responsible Administrator of the animal identification program and traceability initiatives for beef cattle, bison, sheep and pending regulation, cervids and goats in Canada (with exception of Quebec where CCIA only administers bison and goats).

As the Responsible Administrator, CCIA wholly owns and manages the Canadian Livestock Tracking System (CLTS) database.

## HOW TO PREPARE FOR PROPOSED REGULATIONS

**1**

### Obtain a Premises Identification

**Why?** Premises Identification (PID) is a way of linking livestock to land locations. It is the first necessary step in traceability. Having a premises ID number for your operation allows for traceability information to be accessed quickly for the protection of animal health, public health and market access for your industry. A PID will be required once the proposed amendments are implemented.

**How?** By contacting your provincial government, listed on the CCIA website:

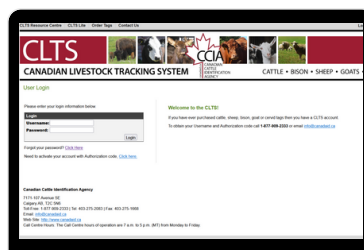

### Create a CLTS Account

**Why?** Make sure your CLTS account is up to date or contact us to create an account. It is your responsibility to share your PID with CCIA to avoid any reporting issues. Your provincial government may not automatically share PID information with us.

### Start Applying Pre-approved Goat Indicators

**Why?** The proposed regulatory amendments include identification requirements for goats. Indicators (tags and leg bands) have been tested and pre-approved prior to the regulations coming into effect.

**How?** All pre-approved goat indicators are available only through the CCIA Webstore.

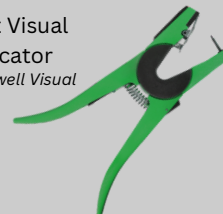
